RJ Corman Railroad has indicated rail crossing closures intermittently in Edinburgh beginning Wednesday, May 31, 2017 and are expected to reopen to traffic sometime Thursday morning, June 1, 2017. The scope of work that is being done is replacing rails in the crossing. Each road will be closed twice. Once to do one side of the rail and once again to replace the other side of the rail. They should only be closed for a few hours at a time and will not be closed overnight. The roads that are going to be affected are the following:
