

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-8

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 OF THE TOWN OF
EDINBURGH'S CODE REGARDING THE INTERSECTION OF
HOUGHAM STREET AND KEELEY STREET**

WHEREAS, the Edinburgh Town Council ("Council") conducted a meeting on the 28th day of April, 2014, to which the Council considered the Edinburgh Planning Commission recommendation to approve Cople's Wrecker Service's petition to rezone Lots Numbered 560, 561 and 562 in Keeley's Magnetic Addition to the Town of Edinburgh, Indiana (parcel number 41-12-34-033-029.001-002) commonly known as 529 Eisenhower Dr, and 508 Keeley St, Edinburgh, Indiana 46124. ("Recommendation")

WHEREAS, the Recommendation contained several conditions that the Edinburgh Planning Commission recommended approving in conjunction with the rezoning of the subject property;

WHEREAS, one of those conditions that was recommended to be adopted by the Edinburgh Planning Commission was to change the intersection of Hougham Street and Keeley Street located in the Town of Edinburgh from a two-way stop to a to a four-way stop; ("Stop Condition")

WHEREAS, the Council having considered the Recommendation and granted the approved the Recommendation along with the Stop Condition;

WHEREAS, the Council has exclusive territorial jurisdiction over intersection of Hougham Street and Keeley Street pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-3-9, in that said street is located in the town limits of the Town of Edinburgh;

WHEREAS, Chapter 74 of the Town of Edinburgh's Code regulates traffic schedules of streets and alleys located within the Town's limits:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE EDINBURGH TOWN COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

I. SECTION 1. TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION

- a. That intersection of Hougham Street and Keeley Street is located within the town limits of the Town of Edinburgh and thus the Council has exclusive territorial jurisdiction over Toner Street pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-3-9.

II. SECTION 2. AMENDMENTS TO CODE

- a. That the Council hereby amends the Town of Edinburgh's Code as follows:
 - i. The following text shall be added to Schedule V of Chapter 74 of the Town of Edinburgh's Code:
 - 1. Under the column labeled Stop Street, the following shall be added:
 - a. "Keeley Street"
 - 2. Under the column labeled Cross Street, the following shall be added directly across from the newly added Keeley Street:
 - a. "Hougham Street"

III. SECTION 3. PUBLIC BENEFIT

- a. That the Edinburgh Town Council finds that this Ordinance will be in the best interest of the Town and for the benefit of the public and residence of the Town.

IV. SECTION 4. REPEALER

- a. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

V. SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY


- a. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the Courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.


VI. SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE


- a. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
