

UPDATED PRESS RELEASE AS OF 5/24/17

RJ Corman Railroad has indicated rail crossing closures intermittently in Edinburgh beginning Wednesday, May 31, 2017. The scope of work that is being done is replacing rails in the crossing. Each road will be closed twice. Once to do one side of the rail and once again to replace the other side of the rail. They should only be closed for a few hours at a time and will not be closed overnight. The roads that are going to be affected are the following:

Wednesday, May 31st - CR 800N, 900N & possibly County Line Road

Thursday, June 1st - County Line Rd, Perry St, Thompson St, Main Cross St & Naomi St

Friday, June 2nd – CR 800N, 900N & possibly County Line Road

Saturday, June 3rd - County Line Rd, Perry St, Thompson St, Main Cross St & Naomi St

Sunday, June 4th – CR 700E and 650S

Monday, June 5th – Private crossing

Tuesday, June 6th - CR 700E and 650S

Wednesday, June 7th – Private crossing

We ask that the public respect and follow the detour route that will be set up. We are sending traffic towards Center Cross St. (State Road 252) since it will remain open throughout the entire process. Please remember with construction work, the schedule can change at any moment due to weather, equipment breakdowns, and other outside factors. We appreciate and value your understanding while we are improving your railroad crossings and roads!
