RJ Corman Railroad has indicated rail crossing closures in Edinburgh beginning Tuesday, June 27, 2017. The scope of work that is being done is replacing ties in the crossing, then the paving contractor will be paving the roads back into service. The roads will be closed until the asphalt cures. This will take several hours depending on the weather and temperature outside. The roads that are going to be affected are the following:

Tuesday, June 27th - County Line Rd, Perry St, Thompson St, Main Cross & Naomi St

We ask that the public respect and follow the detour route that will be set up. We are sending traffic towards Center Cross St. (State Road 252) since it will remain open throughout the entire process. Please remember with construction work, the schedule can change at any moment due to weather, equipment breakdowns, and other outside factors.
