The Fire Chief will oversee all operations of the Fire Department while taking the lead role with safety, budgeting, establishing department policies and procedures, contract negotiations, HR principles for the fire department and serve as liaison with other departments, public safety organizations and the general public. Employee holding this position will be required to perform any other job-related duties as requested by the Town Manager and/or the Town Council. Fire Chief must reside within a 20 minute response time to Edinburgh.

Performance of essential functions may require:

- 2. May require life or death decisions based on circumstance beyond incumbent's control, decisions may affect the general public and co workers as well as incumbent

The Town of Edinburgh is a Drug Free Workplace, successfully passing a post offer drug screen is required and random testing may be conducted after employment

Background checks producing acceptable BMV and criminal history reports are required
